Guideline Changes/New Eligibility Requirements for 04/05 & thereafter

Below are the significant changes/new requirements for eligibility made to the OGP Guidelines for 2004/2005 that will continue for 2005/2006.

This is not the complete set of guidelines. Read the complete 2005/2006 OGP Guidelines carefully before beginning an application.

- Organizations providing any type of service or activity for K-12 aged children
- Arts Education (K-12) school-related Projects – Match Requirements
- Elimination of OGP II – Option 2

Organizations providing any type of service or activity for K-12 aged children

All activities must be Standards-Based

Organizations' arts education activities and programs for K-12 aged children (including activities during the summer, weekends and after-school) must meet elements of the Content Standards for California Public Schools, which include the Visual and Performing Arts Standards, <http://www.cde.ca.gov/shsd/arts/standards.htm>

Arts Education (K-12) school-related Projects

Arts Education (K-12) Projects - Matching Requirements

All applicant organizations requesting funds specifically for a *school-based arts education program must provide a 1:1 match, of which 100% of the organization's match is from the school/district (may include some level of in-kind - see example below). The match requirement demonstrates the school/district's commitment and involvement which is crucial to the goal of institutionalizing arts education in Los Angeles County public schools.

*School-based programs: During –school programs that are conducted in partnership with one or more school(s), primarily benefiting the students of the partnering school(s).

Elimination of OGP II – Option 2

The Arts Commission will no longer offer two separate options in OGP II.

Due to budget restraints and the substantial increase in the remainder of OGP II applicants, Option 2 grant awards of last year and this year are no longer significantly higher than awards in Option 1 and do not justify the additional requirements of Option 2 applicants. Organizations previously funded under Option 2, as well as other OGP II

grantees, will still receive organizational development opportunities and the total allocation for OGP II will be shared equally among all OGP II grantees.
